Recruitment & Admissions

- Conducts high school visits, college fairs, PROBE Fairs, and online events and activities
- Coordinates Open Houses (Fall/Spring and now Degree Completion Open Houses)
- Coordinates individual campus tours
- Purchases names from National Research Center for College and University Admissions (NRCCUA), College Board, ACT
- Visits individual 2-year schools with advisors and prospective students
- Develops print materials and advertisements





- Assists students in applying for federal, state, and institutional aid
- Assists students with personal financial goals by providing financial management programs and tools
- Ensures compliance with federal, State, Board of Regents, and institutional regulations
- Coordinates work study program and scholarships



Registrar's Office



- Maintains the academic records of the university (registration, withdrawals, grades, student file, etc.)
- Upholds the academic policies of the university
- Completes transfer evaluations (new/returning) and readmission to the University
- Coordinates graduation evaluations and commencement ceremonies







- Provides all university-wide, most program-wide, and some community-wide testing
- Administers about 25 different categories of examinations or assessments
- Administers Georgia Assessment for the Certification of Educators (GACE) beginning in October
- Assesses 7,000-9,000 candidates yearly



Orientation & New Student Program



- Assists first year, transfer, nontraditional and dual enrolled students in making a successful academic, intellectual and social transition to the University.
- Provides overall orientation land-based programming and online orientation programming for distance learning students
- Provides peer mentoring to approximately 150 firstyear students enrolled in CSU1022 courses (F.I.R.S.T.
 - Step Peer Mentoring Program)
- Coordinates New Student
 Convocation



First-Year Advising & Retention Center



- Provides holistic advising that addresses the developmental needs of students.
- Coordinates CSU 1022 course, learning community program, and First-Year Common Reading
- Coordinates MAP-Works Retention Management Program
- Guides students to identify a major program of study that best matches their educational and career goals.
- Coordinates service learning projects to develop a sense of self, social responsibility and civility for students.
- Encourages superior academic achievement by building a community of scholars through a freshman honor society.

Center for Academic Success




- Coordinates peer tutoring in over 75 courses

- Coordinates end of semester Tutoring Blitz






Fall Enrollment Comparisons








Spring Enrollment Comparisons








Summer Enrollment Comparisons



First-Time, Full-Time Freshmen Retention History






Plans for Upcoming Year
