Effective July 1, 2021, the GaPSC will accept a PAA composite score that allows a test taker to score less than 250 on one or more of the PAA tests and still meet the PAA requirement. A test taker who does not pass the PAA by scoring 250 or higher on each test will be able to combine the scores on all three tests within the PAA to meet the PAA requirement provided the combined score is 750 or higher. Therefore, a test taker can do well on one test(s) and less well on another test(s) within the PAA and potentially still satisfy the PAA requirement.

## Options to Exempt the Program Admission Assessment Requirement

Currently there are several ways to meet the Georgia Program Admission assessment requirement:

Having the required minimum SAT<sup>®</sup>, ACT<sup>®</sup>, or GRE<sup>®</sup> score. Actual scores, not exemption codes, are required.

#### **SAT®** - Score Reports dated prior to 7/1/19:

#### 1000 on Verbal/Critical Reading, and Math or

1000 on Evidence-based Reading/Writing and Math

Only scores from the official SAT<sup>®</sup> (English version) can be considered.

If you took the ACT<sup>®</sup> before September, 2006, request your scores in one of three ways for \$17 - By phone: Call the ACT<sup>®</sup> help desk between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm CT. For an extra \$12, they can prioritize your search and get the scores to you faster. Online: Request your scores <u>online</u> if you know your test date. By mail: Write a letter with the following info: name, Social Security number, date of birth, test date, where you want scores sent, current address, phone number, check or money order for total cost payable to ACT Records.
