Effective March 16, 2020, the University System of Georgis directed all institutions to move fully to remote instruction for the remainder of the semester, with extremely limited exceptions. Additionally, residence halls will be closed, with minimal exceptions for students unable to return home, or who cannot find housing elsewhere. IF A STUDENT OWES THE UNIVERSITY, THE DEBT WILL BE SATISFIED FIRST AND ANY REMAINING CREDIT BALANCE WILL BE REFUNDED TO THE STUDENT.
