

Student Code of Conduct Agreement, Acknowledgment and Adherence to Policy

By enrolling in a Clayton State University Center for Continuing and Professional Education course, students agree to conduct themselves at all times in a manner conducive to the promotion of a positive and pleasant learning environment for themselves and others.
